# I. NO ONE <u>INFLUENCED</u> THE WORLD LIKE JESUS CHRIST

Someone once said, "Christmas is when God came down the stairs of heaven with a baby in His arms"

Real story: "Christmas is when God came down the stairs of heaven with a Savior in His arms"

A. Sent by God

Jesus Christ is the only one who ever <u>lived</u> before He was born

"Father, restore unto me the glory that I had with you before the world was" (see John 17:24)

"I proceeded forth and came from God...He sent me"

John 8:42

"I have come down from Heaven" John 6:38 Jesus Christ, the only one God ever sent

- If our greatest need was information, God would have sent an educator
- If our greatest need was technology, God would have sent us a scientist
- If our greatest need was money, God would have sent us an economist

If our greatest need was pleasure, God would have sent us an entertainer

But our greatest need was forgiveness, so God sent us a Savior

B. The Son of God; Mysteries of the Incarnation

God becoming man

Paul told Timothy, "Great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh" 1 Timothy 3:16

Term: Son of God, means deity – He's God

Jesus never "became" God, He was God, before He
was born, after He became man

God sent His Son to reveal Himself to the world.

C. Jesus was Surrendered to God

Philip Yancey wrote, "Imagine for a moment becoming a baby again; imagine giving up language and muscle coordination; imagine losing the ability to eat solid food and control your bladder.

C. Jesus was Surrendered to God

God as a fetus. Or, imagine yourself becoming a sea slug, that analogy is probably closer. On that day in Bethlehem the Maker of all that is took the form of a helpless, dependent new-born."

### III. Closing Thoughts – God sent His Son, a Savior

We are the ones who have exalted Saint Nicholas to a job he never had
