B. The Claims of Jesus Himself C. S. Lewis

"A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said wouldn't be a great moral teacher.

He'd either be a lunatic on the level of a man who says he's a poached egg or else he'd be the devil of hell. You must make your choice; either this man was and is the Son of God or else a madman or something worse."

- 1. To the <u>Samaritan woman</u> he said, "Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again. But whoever drinks of the water that I shall give will never thirst."
- 2. To the <u>crowds</u> in john 6, Jesus said, "I am the bread of life. Anyone who eats of this will live forever."

3. To the <u>leaders</u> in John 8, Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness."

4. In John 8, again to the <u>leaders</u>, "I am from above, you are from below. I am not of this world."

5. In the same chapter, "Before <u>Abraham</u> existed (or was) I existed (or I Am)."

6. In John 10 he said, "I am the <u>door</u>, those who come in through me will be saved."

7. John 11, "I am the <u>resurrection</u> and the life. Whoever believes in me, even though he dies, yet shall he live."

8. John 14, "I am the <u>way</u>, the truth and the <u>life</u>. No one comes to the Father except through me."

9. Same chapter He said to <u>Phillip</u> he said, "Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father."

10 John 18 to Pontius <u>Pilate</u> he said, "You say that I am a king and you're right. For this reason, for this purpose I was born.".

11. He says he's the quencher of <u>thirst</u>, satisfier of <u>hunger</u>, light of the world, that he's from <u>heaven</u>, that he predates <u>Abraham</u>, that he's the door of salvation, that he's the <u>exact</u> representation of his Father and that he is the king.
