1 Peter 5:5-7

The Upright Walk of a Bowed-Down Man

I. Responding to Authority <u>Helps</u> Leadership (v. 5a) Nothing is more helpful to those who are in authority than those who will compliantly <u>respond</u> to that authority

You can't be saved without <u>submission</u>: to be saved, you have to repent and live in submission to an alien will

You cannot follow Christ unless you are willing to submit to Christ

2.Living in Humility <u>Enhances</u> Fellowship (v. 5b)
Submission and humility are the <u>lubricants</u>, the oil when the gears get tight in relationships
Keeps Others <u>Accessible</u> to You

<u>Voluntarily</u> adapt yourselves to each other, or blend with one another

Be willing to <u>surrender</u> your rights Keeps God from <u>Fighting</u> You

3. Resting in Sovereignty <u>Acknowledges</u> Lordship (vv. 6-7)

Permits God to Promote You

The "mighty hand of God" was often used in the Old Testament to describe God's power of delivering His people who were in trouble

Prohibits Trouble from Consuming You

The one message you need to walk away with is that God cares for you

Closing Thoughts

1. Submission, humility, and resting are not instantaneous or natural things

It takes a period of time, and it's supernatural It's part of the <u>sanctification</u> process
