2nd Timothy 2:1-7

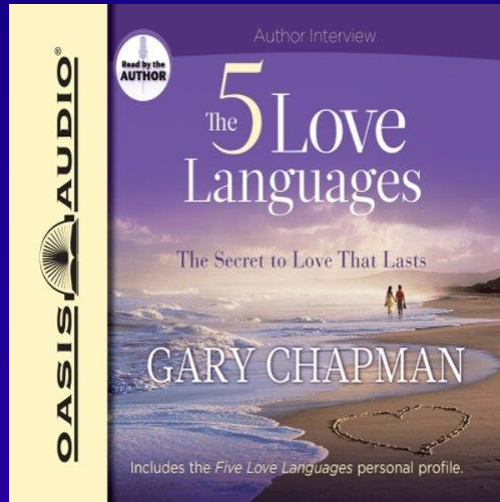
