By Our <u>Gentle</u> Response (v. 9) "Be Good, Be Kind, Be Gentle" Frank Rossiter <u>Bless</u> back that you might get a <u>blessing</u> Imprecatory Psalms

Persecutions on earth today will add blessings to you in heaven tomorrow (Matthew 5:11-12) HOW TO ATTRACT FLIES By your general attitude of love By your gentle response of blessing

By Our Genuine <u>Motivation</u> (vv. 10-12) Peter quotes the Old Testament (Psalm 34)

It takes the whole Bible to make a whole believer This is the way to have a good life: if you love life, then love people

Joie de vivre (French), describes someone who is a lover of life—vs. Solomon (see Ecclesiastes 2:17)

Because God is <u>watching</u>

Watching = superintending, watching over with care, protecting, listening to

You don't need to worry about the people who do you evil; God sees it, notices, and will take care of it

This whole passage (1 Peter 3:8-12) describes God's character (Romans 5:8)

⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
