Jesus heals the Centurion's slave

The Centurion felt unworthy for Jesus to come
into his house

The Centurion was in charge of 100 soldiers

Jesus marveled at the Centurion's faith

“I say to you no not even in Israel have I
found such great faith

The Profile of the Centurion

He was a friend to the people

He must have witnessed the worship of the Jews
in the synagogue

He had become a proselyte

He built the synagogue

What is Faith?

Faith is defined in Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for and the conviction of things not seen.

Faith is what we need to see us through any situation

When you are down to nothing

God is up to something

What Jesus Said and Did About Death (Vs.11-17)

There were two crowds, the crowd following Jesus and the crowd coming from Capernaum

Two only sons met

Notice two suffers met –Jesus and the widow of Nain

1. What Jesus Said and Did About Doubt (vs.18-35)

John the Baptist in prison doubted that Jesus
was the Messiah
