3. God is omnipresent-He is present everywhere

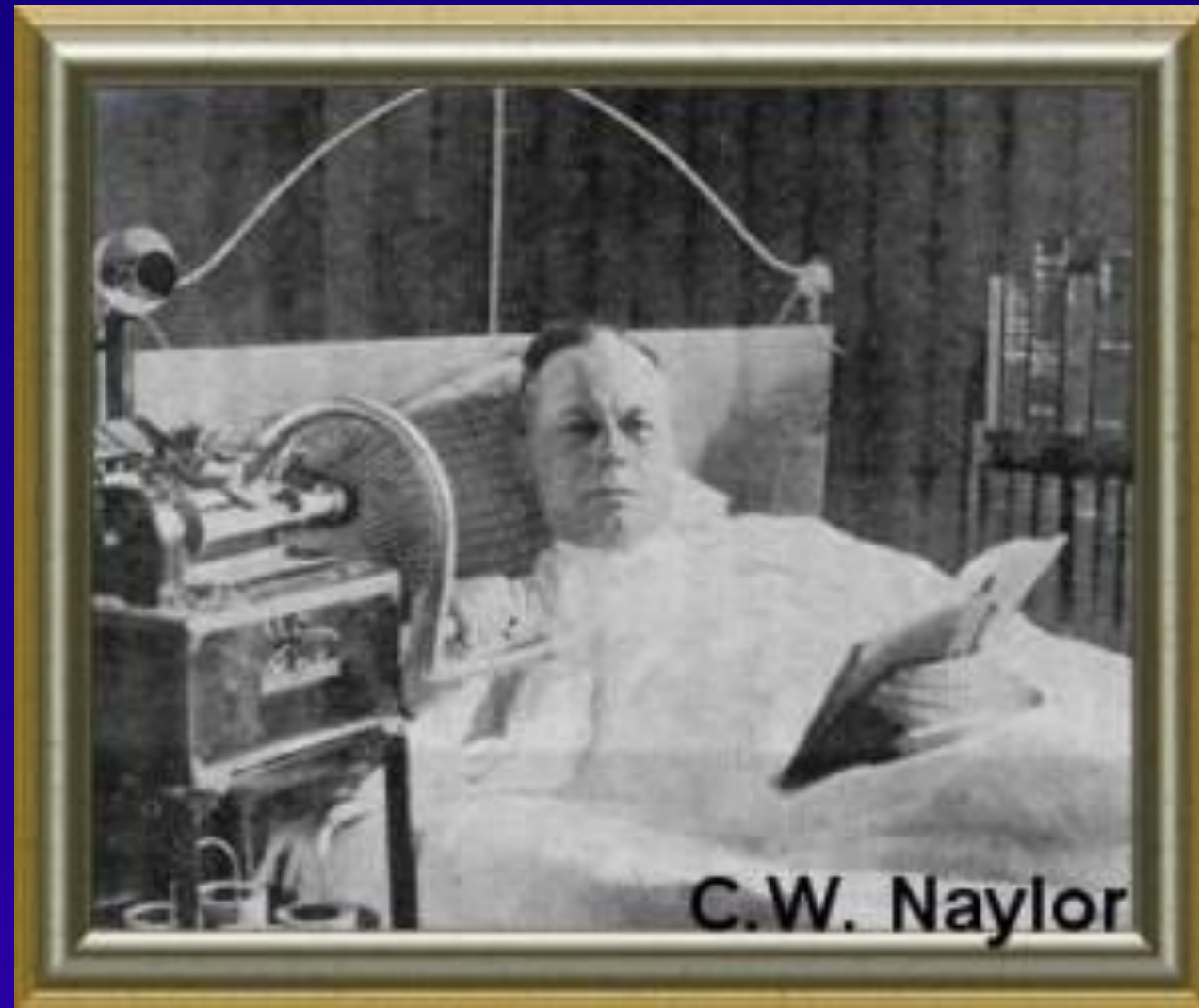
Genuine Worship is a Reverential **Fear** of God
