II. Baptism Relates to the Past (vv. 20-21) Noah's Flood: The Type An *antitype* is something formed after some pattern; or, that which corresponds to a type Flood waters of Noah are the type Baptismal waters of the believer are the antitype

II. Baptism Relates to the <u>Past</u> (vv. 20-21)

Baptism: The Antitype There was only one doorway in the ark—one way of salvation that you go through So it is with Jesus

II. Baptism Relates to the Past (vv. 20-21)

John 14:6

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

III. Baptism Recalls a Principle (v. 21a)

Baptism is a visible practice of an <u>invisible</u> principle Its Meaning

Greek *baptizó* meaning to dip, dunk, or drown; to be immersed in something—anything

III. Baptism Recalls a <u>Principle</u> (v. 21a) 1 Corinthians 10:2 and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea: Luke 12:50 But I have a baptism to undergo, and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!

III. Baptism Recalls a <u>Principle</u> (v. 21a) 1 Corinthians 12:13

For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. III. Baptism Recalls a <u>Principle</u> (v. 21a)Matthew 3:11, Luke 3:16 (the three baptisms)As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but

He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

III. Baptism Recalls a <u>Principle</u> (v. 21a) Its Origin

Symbolized a Gentile leaving the pagan world and coming to a whole new lifeA *mikvah* is a pool for baptism, for cleansing before entering the temple

III. Baptism Recalls a <u>Principle</u> (v. 21a) Its Practice

How did baptism come to be a Christian thing? John the Baptizer

It was a baptism unto repentance (see Mark 1:4 and Matthew 3:5-6)—these Jews were admitting that they were outsiders and that their religion wasn't enough

IV. Baptism Reveals <u>Power (v. 21b)</u> Jesus' power through His resurrection The Power of a Good Conscience Do you have to be baptized to be saved? No—you have to be saved to be baptized IV. Baptism Reveals <u>Power</u> (v. 21b) Acts 8:26-39 Mark 16:16

He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned. Baptism follows faith

IV. Baptism Reveals <u>Power (v. 21b)</u> Acts 2:38

For in Greek is eis, meaning for, in order that, or because of

Modern translations say, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ as an expression of the remission of your sins"

Why should I be baptized? Instruction Jesus commanded it John 14:15 "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments"

Why should I be baptized? <u>Identification</u>

Romans 6:3-4

Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death? ⁴ Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death,

Why should I be baptized? <u>Identification</u>

Romans 6:3-4

⁴ Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. It makes your salvation personal

Closing

Jesus was immersed in <u>suffering</u> so you could be immersed in <u>salvation</u>

He was immersed in pain so you might be immersed in peace

He was immersed in <u>death</u> so you and I can be saturated and <u>immersed</u> in life
