The Great Commission A. You Have a Mission: Share what we know about Christ with others 1. We continue the ministry of Christ on earth a. "The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach" (Acts 1:1)

The Great Commission You Have the <u>Resources</u>

"If you forgive the sins of any, they have already been forgiven. If you retain the sins of any, they have already been retained"—Julius Mantey

We cannot provide forgiveness for any person: "Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

(Mark 2:7)

The Great Commission You Have the **Resources** We can proclaim forgiveness Tell the good news about the slain, resurrected Christ When one receives Christ we can proclaim with authority, "You are forgiven" When one rejects, we can proclaim "You are not forgiven, your sin remains"

V. The Enabling of <u>Power (v. 22)</u> The Gift of the Holy Spirit
A. At the first creation, God breathed into man's nostrils the breath of <u>life</u>, resulting in <u>physical</u> life

B. In the second creation, Jesus breathes into man <u>spiritual</u> life

C .In both Hebrew and Greek, the word "breath" is the same word for "<u>spirit</u>"

V. The Enabling of <u>Power (v. 22)</u> The Gift of the Holy Spirit
D. Pledge that they will receive the baptism of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>
1. We can't do it alone

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth"

(Acts 1:8)
