# THE NEED FOR CONFIDENCE AND REST IN UNCERTAIN TIMES Daniel 11:36-45

People long for someone to come along and fix it all

Time Magazine article: "Inflation, Who Hurts the Worst?"

There is one coming, but you don't want to follow him—a coming world leader with a plan

Four attributes of the coming leader 1.His <u>arrogance</u> vs.36

The angel of the Lord who is giving the vision skips thousands of years from

verse 35 to verse 36—he is dealing with someone in the future

There are gaps of time in the Bible (i.e. "70 weeks of years" Daniel 9;

Jesus read from Isaiah 61; Principle: prophetic foreshortening

We know this because there are 135 well-documented fulfilled prophecies that corroborate data

Nothing in this verse onward has been fulfilled—the time of the end

"At that time" —a period of time that is worse than any other period that has ever happened Why is there a gap here?

The prophecies are dealing with one particular nation, <u>Israel</u>

Jacob's trouble (see Jeremiah 30)

All the conflicts that have already been fulfilled are just a foreshadow of a worse time that is coming

The king mentioned is the antichrist He's only called that in

1 John2:18,2:22,4:3 & 2 John 7

That's his most infamous title

He's given 25 titles (the beast, the lawless one, the son of perdition, the man of sin, the little horn, the king of fierce countenance, the prince that shall come, etc.)

One of his notable characteristics is his <u>pride</u>
You can rest in God's <u>promise</u>- Proverbs 16:18

Pride goeth before destruction and a haughty spirit before a fall.

II. His aberration vs.37

He will show no regard for the gods of his fathers or for the desire of women, nor will he show regard for any *other* god; for he will magnify himself above *them* all.

Three areas of peculiarity

- a. He will not regard the heritage of his fathers
  - b. He will not regard the desire of women
  - c. He will not regard any God, he will exalt himself above them all—Paul says the same thing in

2 Thessalonians 2:4

Possibility: Antichrist may have Islamic origins
Problem number one: the revived Roman
Empire

Roman Empire split in 395AD Modern-day Turkey

Today 60% of the Roman territory is under Islamic control

Problem number two: any Muslim would never allow someone to claim they were God

You can rest on God's proclamation

God will not share His glory with another – Isaiah 42:8

"I am the Lord that is My name; I will not give My glory to another,

III. His association vs.38

But instead he will honor a god of fortresses, a god whom his fathers did not know; he will honor *him* with gold, silver, costly stones and treasures.

Fortress means strong tower

How can anyone find confidence and rest with a powerful, prideful, peculiar, political oppressor like this guy?

You can rest in His power

Matthew 23:12

"Whoever exalts himself is going to be abased"

IV. His Annihilation v. 40

"At the end time the king of the South will collide with him, and the king of the North will storm against him with chariots, with horsemen and with many ships; and he will enter countries, overflow *them* and pass through.

How does he come to his end?

Revelation 19

Jesus comes back with the armies of heaven, captures him, and casts him into the lake of fire
