FUTURISTIC DREAMS Daniel 7

The dream that Daniel got corresponded to the dream that Nebuchadnezzar had years before Nebuchadnezzar saw a huge, beautiful <u>statue</u> Daniel saw four wild <u>beasts</u> Nebuchadnezzar saw it from a <u>worldly</u> perspective

Daniel saw it from <u>God's</u> perspective God sees from the <u>heavenly</u> perspective; He is not impressed with outward appearances Sons of Jesse God looks at the heart (see 1 Samuel 16:7)

A creature like a <u>lion</u> Symbol of <u>Babylon</u>—winged lion Wings plucked—indicates loss of power humbled by God

> Beast like a <u>bear</u> <u>Medo-Persian</u> empire Bear is slower than a lion Bear has brute force Hard to stop a bear

King Xerxes of Persia assembled 2,500,000 troops—moved slowly but with great power Lopsided bear—Persians more powerful than the Medes

Beast like a leopard Incredibly fast Kingdom of Greece Alexander the Great took over the world Known for speed of victory and the speed of the breakup of his kingdom

Iron-toothed beast Iron rule of Rome Corresponds to the iron legs This corresponds to Revelation 13 where John sees "a beast coming out of the sea" (Revelation 13:1)

The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:9-10 As I looked. "thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took his seat. His clothing was as white as snow; the hair of his head was white like wool. The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:9-10

His throne was flaming with fire, and its wheels were all ablaze. ¹⁰ A river of fire was flowing, coming out from before him.

The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:9-10

Thousands upon thousands attended him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him.

> The court was seated, and the books were opened

The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:11-14

¹¹ "Then I continued to watch because of the boastful words the horn was speaking. I kept looking until the beast was slain and its body destroyed and thrown into the blazing fire. ¹² (The other beasts had been stripped of their authority, but were allowed to live for a period of time.)

The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:13

¹³ "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence.

The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:14

¹⁴ He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that will not pass away, and his kingdom is one that will never be destroyed.

¹⁵ "As for me, Daniel, my spirit was distressed within me, and the visions in my mind kept alarming me. ¹⁶ I approached one of those who were standing by and began asking him the exact meaning of all this. So he told me and made known to me the interpretation of these things:
