

The meeting of Jesus and Nicodemus at night is one of the most famous and compelling stories in Scripture. This man's inner curiosity and spiritual thirst drove him to want to know more. What he heard puzzled and astonished him, but he heard from Jesus' own lips the only way to be saved. Jesus' words here divide all of humanity into two groups: those who are born again and those who are not.

I. Spiritual <u>Curiosity</u> (vv. 1-2) The Man Named Nicodemus – Nicodemus was religious, rich, and he was a ruler

<u>Religious</u> -<u>Pharisee</u> - pledged to keep all of the law. Not just the first 5 books of the Bible, but the oral law as well; the Mishnah and the Talmud

Rich - according to the Talmud one of four richest men in Jerusalem. Brought the myrrh and aloes when Jesus was buried. Ruler - His name is Greek, means "victor over the people." Ruler, archon in Greek. He was "the" teacher in Israel. One of the most famous, sought after lecturers.

Nick at Nite John 3:1-8 The Meeting at <u>Night</u> Could be a lot of reasons he came at night. Fear Sin Probably for <u>quality</u> time with Jesus. He came. Nicodemus called Jesus, "Rabbi."

Eternal Necessity (vv. 3-6) Unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom. Jesus answers the question that Nicodemus didn't ask. Jesus knew what was in man. "Most assuredly" is our clue that these are important word. The Meaning of the New Birth

New life, second chance. Gennethe anothen -Born from <u>above</u> Born a <u>second</u> time

To have new life, you need a <u>new</u> birth. You are born spiritually <u>dead.</u> (Ephesians 2:1)

The Method of the New Birth -born of water and the spirit Doesn't mean baptismal regeneration. Nicodemus couldn't have understood New Testament baptism. Jesus didn't baptize anyone

Spiritual cleansing- Old Testament description of being spiritually cleansed. Ezekiel 36. Physical birth followed by Spiritual birth. "Born of water" physical birth "Born of the spirit" spiritual birth First birth necessary for physical life Second birth necessary for spiritual life

Observable Activity (vv. 7-8)

The Wind Changes <u>Places</u>-can't see it, but the effects of it are plainly observable.

The Spirit Changes <u>People</u> - When a person is born again the changes are <u>observable</u>. Pneuma is the word for wind and spirit. Same word.

George Whitfield said he taught on this passage so much, because Jesus said you must be born again. Jesus said you MUST be born again. He was saying this to a religious person. Status, religion and good works were not enough.

Born once (physically) Die twice (physically and spiritually) Born twice (physically and spiritually) Die once (physically) Jesus doesn't reform you; He <u>transforms</u> you.

A suggested prayer to pray Lord Jesus, I need You. Thank You for dying on the cross for my sins. I open the door of my life and receive You as my Savior and Lord. Thank You for forgiving my sins and giving me Eternal life. Take control of the throne of my life. Make me the kind of person You want me to be

If you have sincerely prayed this prayer you have just been "born again"
