God's Call to Conquest

Joshua 1:10-11

God bringing the Jews out of Egypt-

that is a picture of our being **redeemed** by the blood of the Lamb, for the Passover Lamb was slain that night

The wilderness experience typifies a **carnal** Christian

The land of Canaan represents the **fullness** of the Christian Life

1. A Call to Preparation

¹¹Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals

Manna was their desert diet

Manna means what is this?

Manna had a taste of oil and it had a taste of
honey

1.A Call to Preparation

Numbers 11:8

⁸And the people went about, and gathered it, and ground it in mills, or beat it in a mortar, and baked it in pans, and made cakes of it: and the taste of it was as the taste of fresh oil.

Exodus 16:31

³¹ The people of Israel called the bread manna. It was white like coriander seed and tasted like wafers made with honey

1.A Call to Preparation

Numbers 11:4

And the mixed multitude that was among them fell a lusting and the children of Israel also wept again and said who shall give us flesh to eat. I want a steak. We remember the fish which we did eat in Egypt freely, the cucumbers and the melons and the leeks and the onions and the garlic, now our soul is dried away, there is nothing at all beside this manna before our eyes

2. A Call to Anticipation

¹¹Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within **three days** ye shall pass over this Jordan,

Three days speaks of the resurrection life
Coming out of Egypt pictures redemption
Going into Canaan pictures sanctification

2. A Call to Anticipation

Romans 5:10

For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

We were **reconciled** to God

by the death of his Son,

We are saved by the **life of Jesus**

3. A Call to Separation

¹²And to the Reubenites, and to the Gadites, and to half the tribe of Manasseh,

spake Joshua, saying,

¹³Remember the word which Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you
