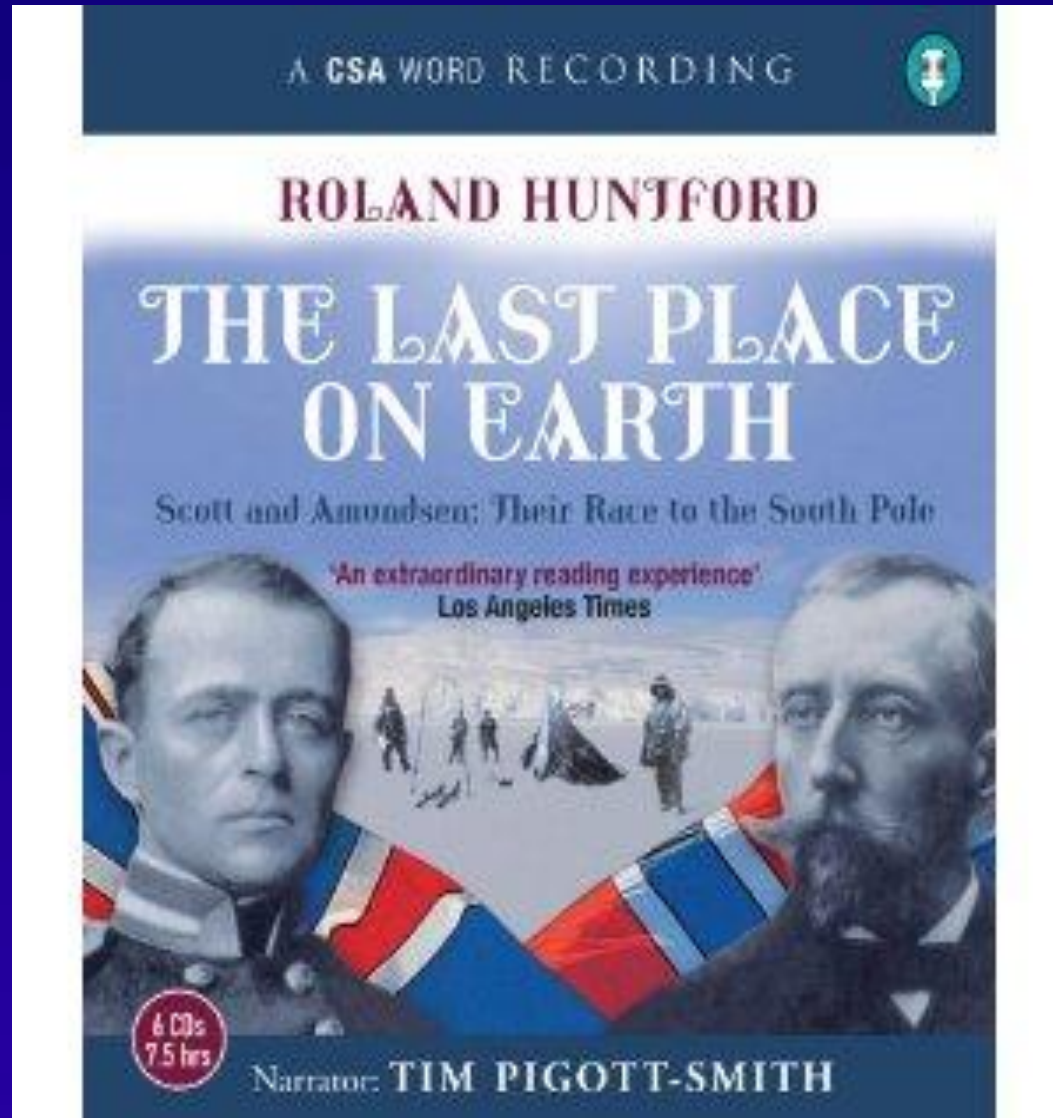

 1. You have to be willing to reach this goal in the most difficult times and circumstances.
 2. You have to hold back or not overreach even in the most ideal or best of times.

1911

The average life expectancy for men was 47 years.

Fuel for automobiles was sold in drug stores only.

Regulates the stomach and bowels, and is, in fact, a perfect guardian of health!" (Shocking?)

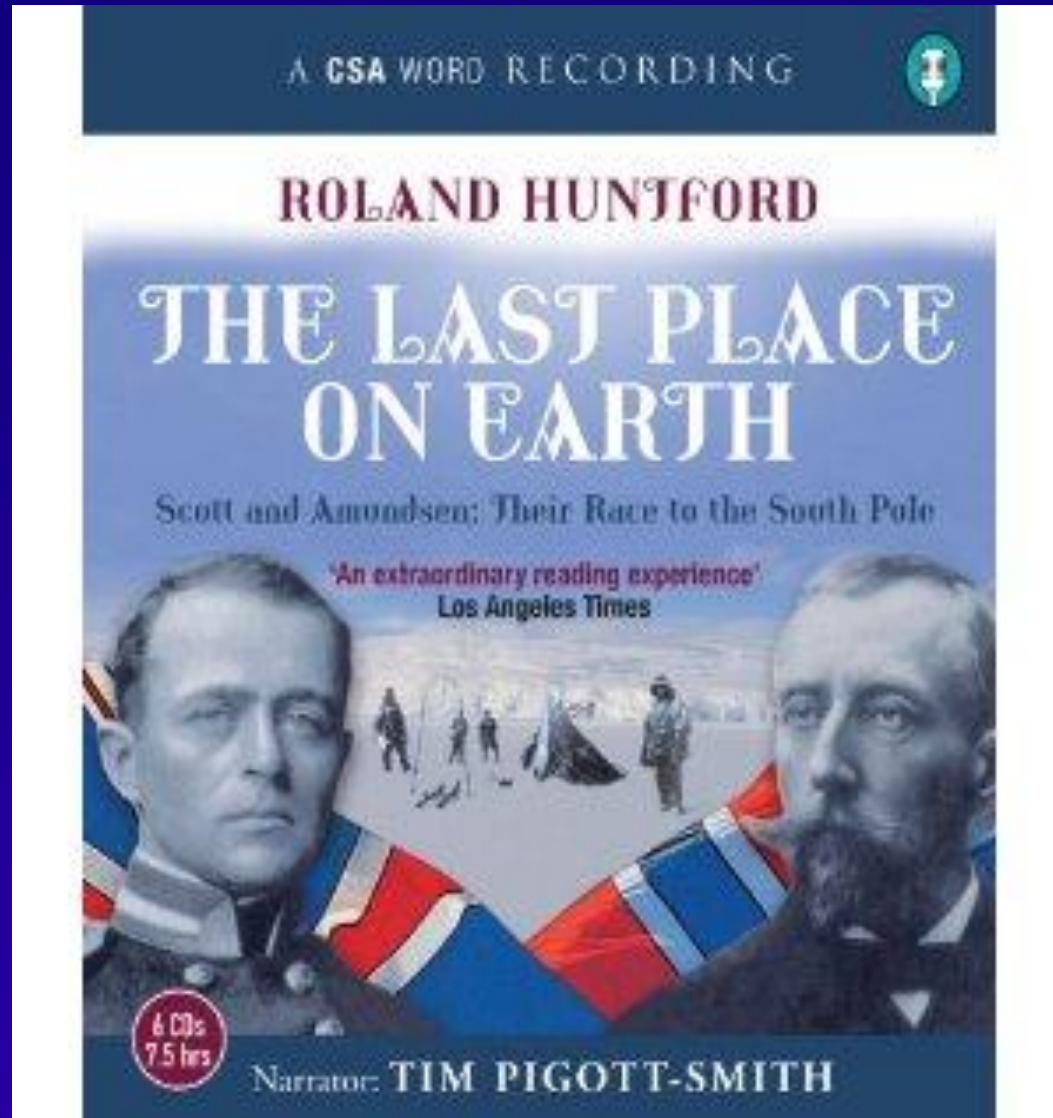
Eighteen percent of households had at least one full-time servant or domestic help.

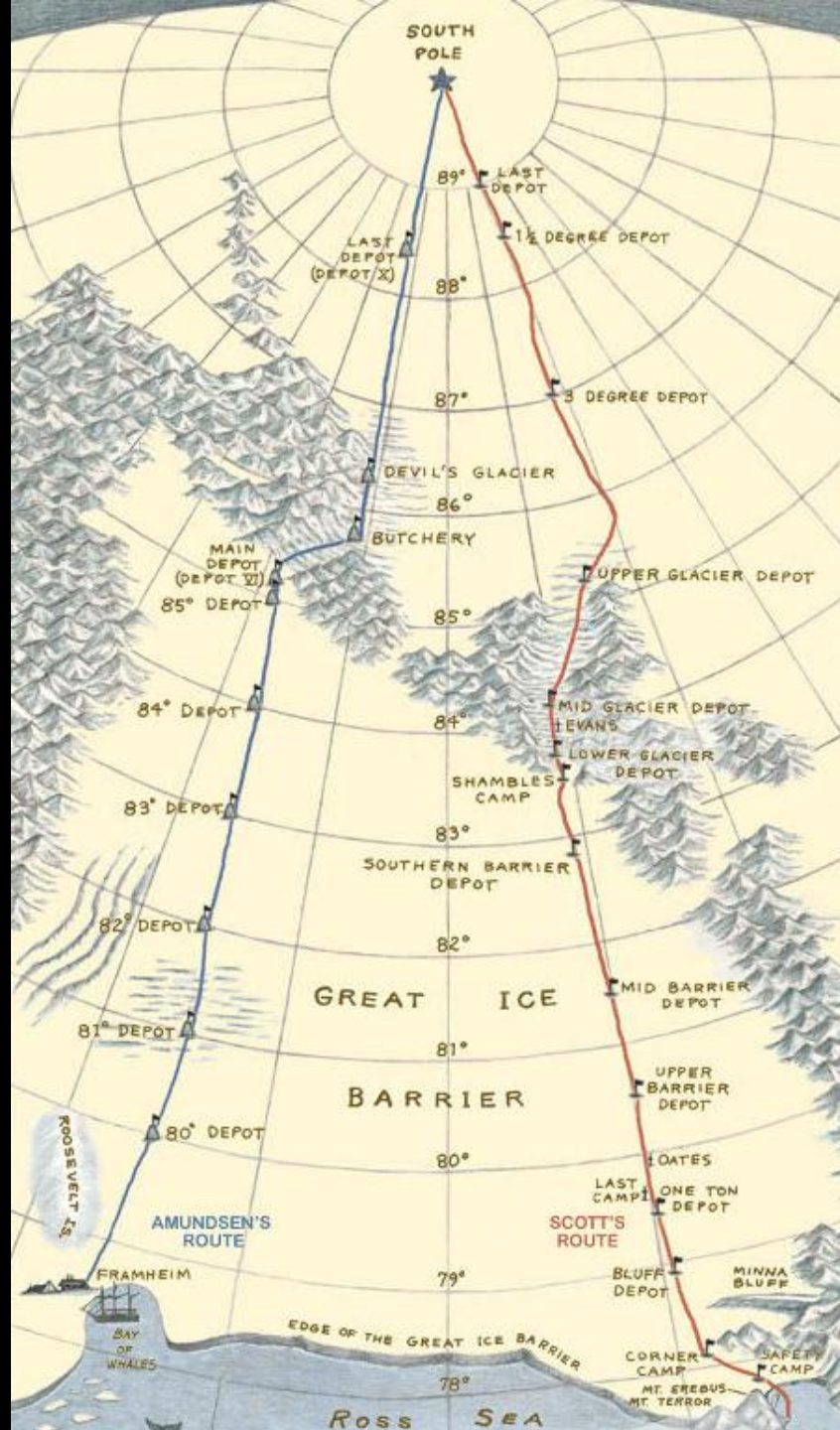

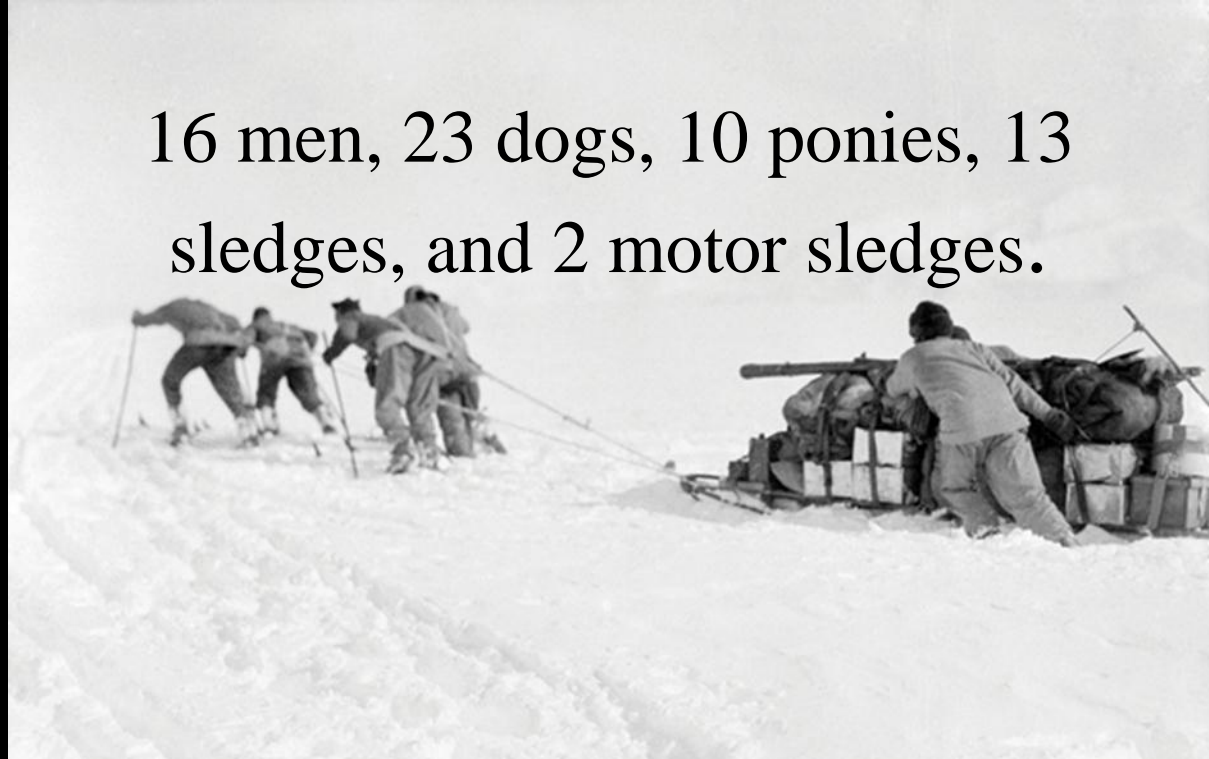
Robert Scott (Britain) – Roald Amundsen (Norway)





Scott's Plan

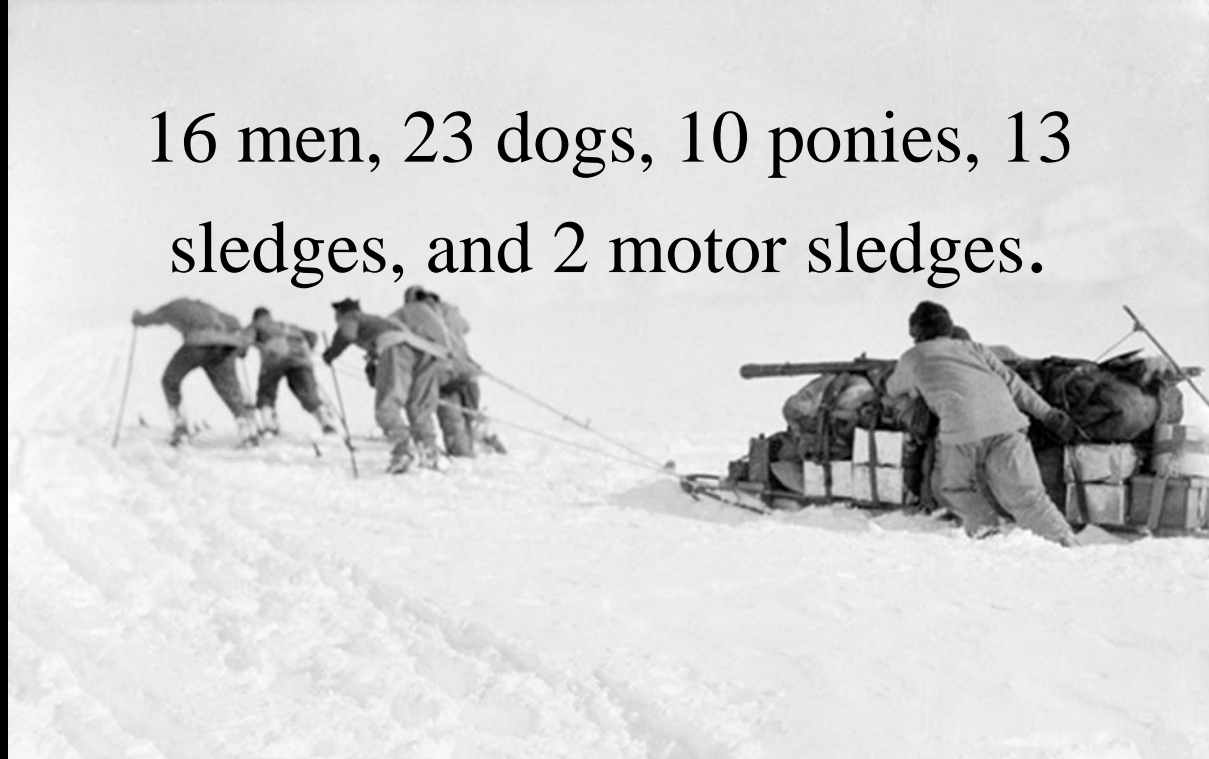
16 men, 23 dogs, 10 ponies, 13 sledges, and 2 motor sledges.



Ponies sweat, eat hay and grass and need a large amount of water. The only way to get water was to melt ice and snow and that takes fuel.

16 men, 23 dogs, 10 ponies, 13 sledges, and 2 motor sledges.

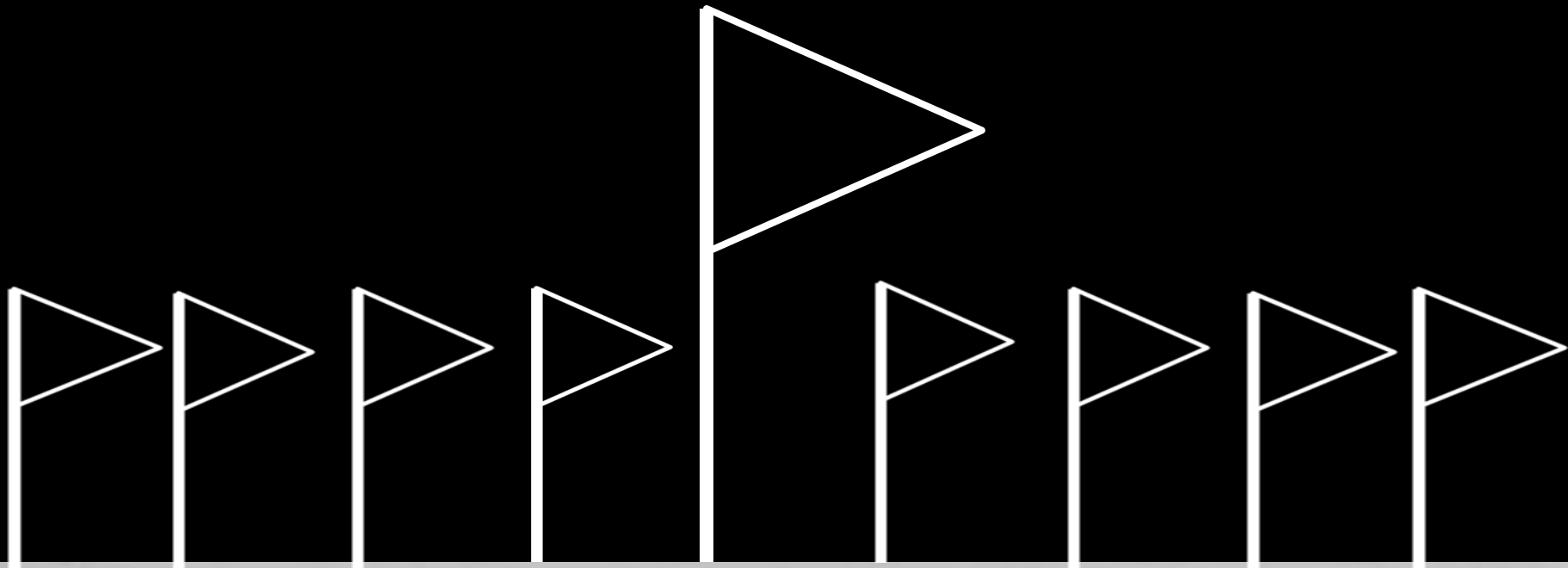


Everything Scott did was based on the FAILED attempt of Shackleton a few years before. He repeated every mistake without exception. He even used modern clothes

Amundsen Plan

5 men on skis
52 dogs,
4 sledges





Scott used 1 flag

Amundsen used 10
flags



20 Mile March

The two explorers were very different

1. You have to be willing to reach this goal in the most difficult times and circumstances.

- Amundsen averaged 15 to 20 miles a day after day.
- Scott averaged 7 or 8 miles a day when he traveled.

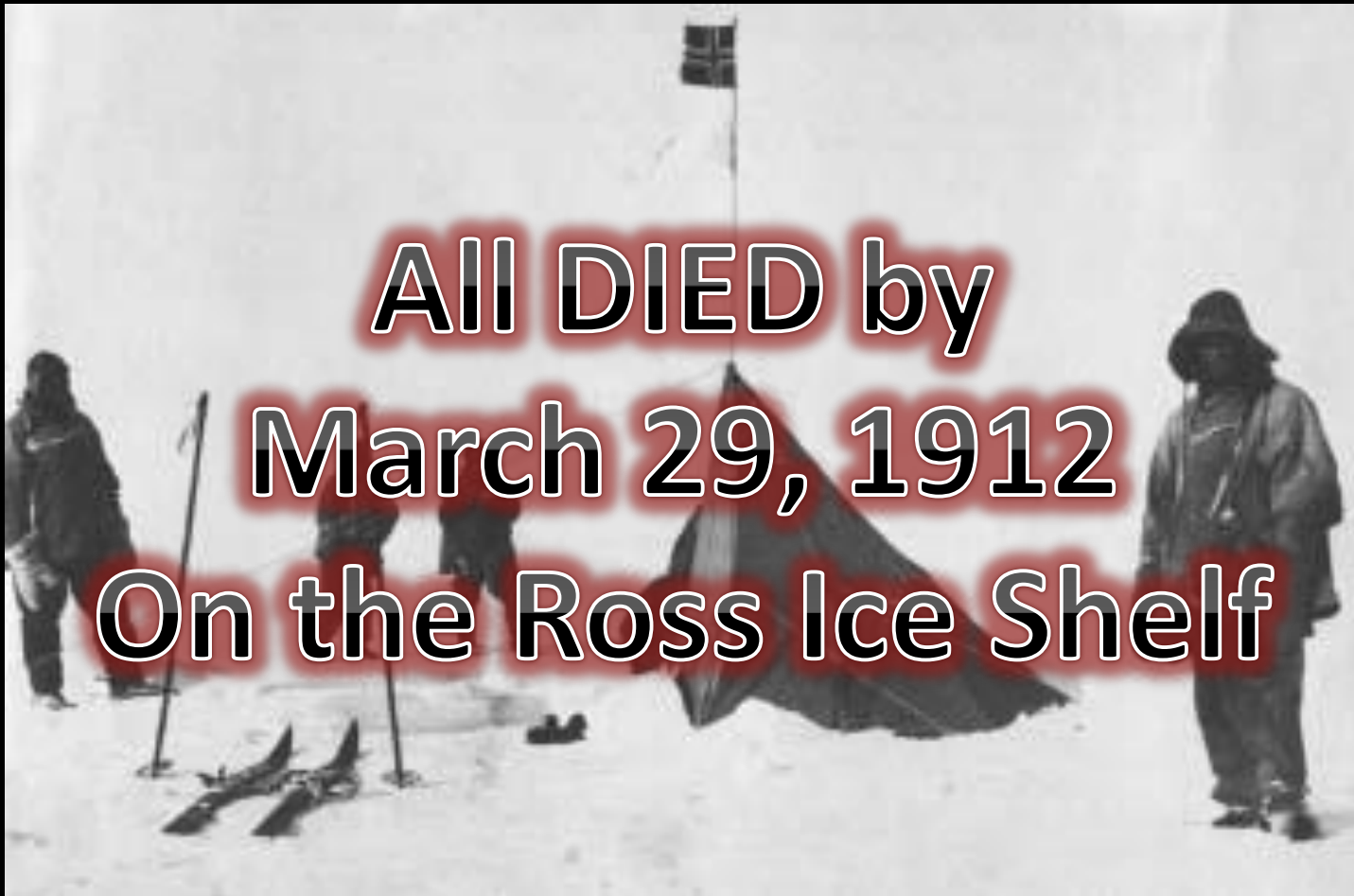
2. You have to hold back or not overreach even in the most ideal or best of times.

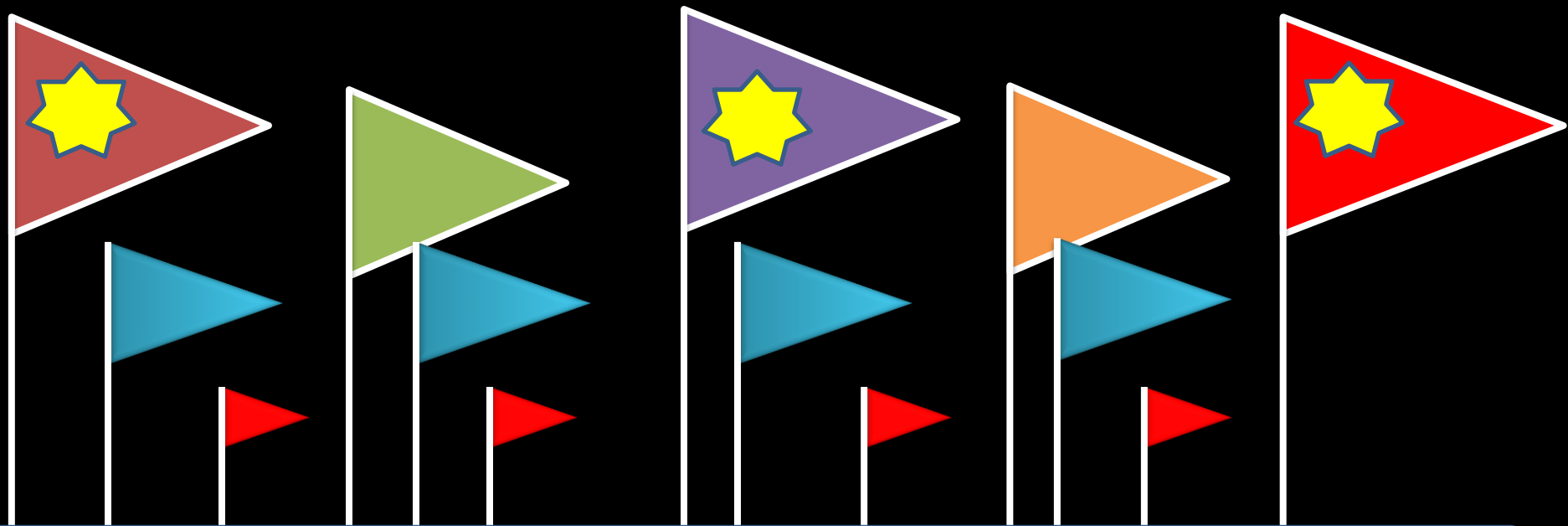
- Scott pushed his men to **exhaustion** on the days he traveled.
- Amundsen stuck to the plan even in ideal conditions and was always rested.

Amundsen December 14-17 1911



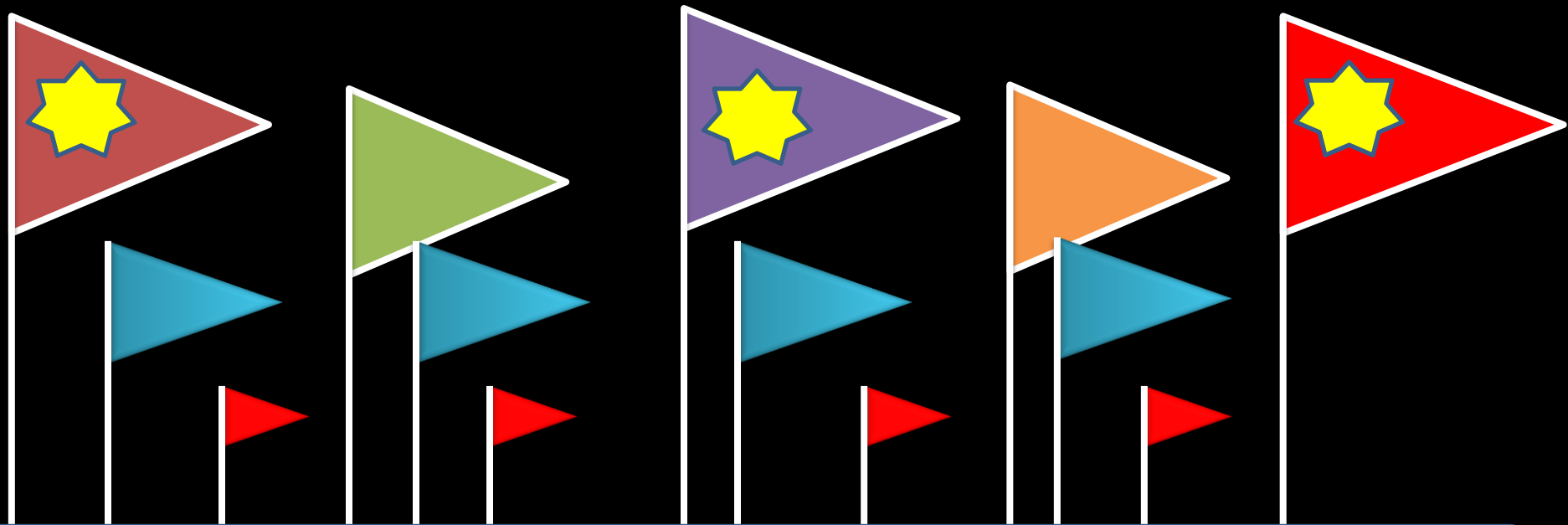
Scott January 17th 1912

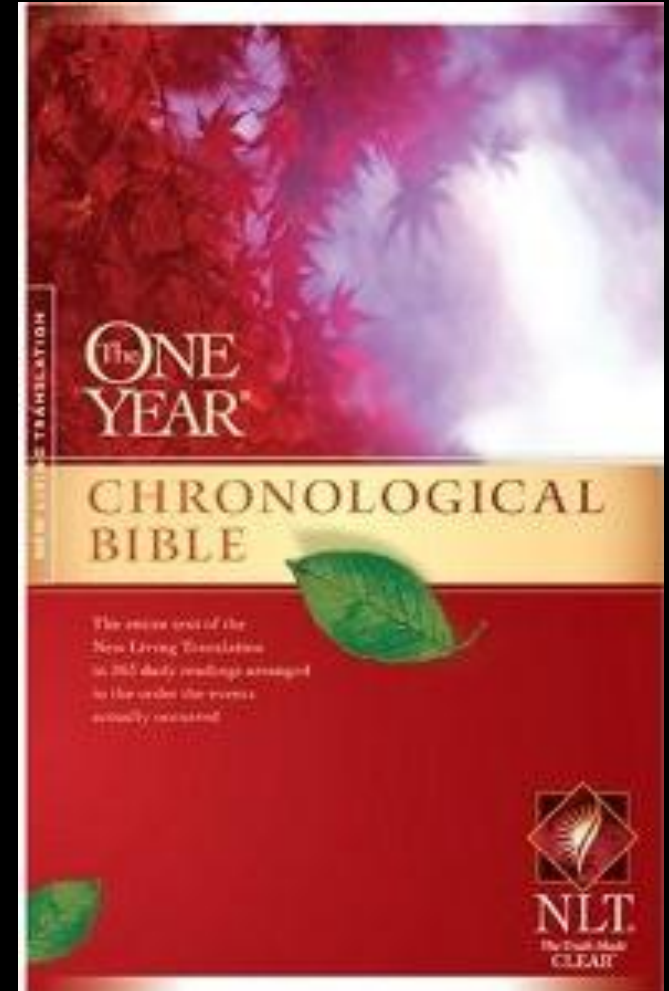
