The Christian's Secret of Dealing with

Trouble

Matthew 6:34

Do not be anxious for tomorrow; for tomorrow will care for i self. Each day has enough trouble of its own

What Matthew 6 doesn't mean Matthew 6:34

1. You <u>shouldn't</u> make appropriate preparations for something, you're to take care of tomorrow What Matthew 6 doesn't mean Matthew 6:34
2. The point of Matthew 6 Is not: don't make wise preparations.

> The point is: don't bring the troubles and uncertainties of carrying out those preparations tomorrow into day

What is Meant by Enough? He means that your sovereign heavenly Father, who is kind and wise beyond all measure, gives unto each day what he deems best, lovingly its part of pain and pleasure.

> Each day's troubles are "enough"—they are "sufficient"-because God determines their imit. God decides what is enough and what is sufficient

I Cor.10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

<u>God's Way to Handle Trouble</u> Matthew 6:34 Live <u>one</u> day at a time

Don't be anxious about tomorrow it will be anxious for itself sufficient enough trouble will be there tomorrow for that day according to our Heavenly Father's bestowment

<u>God's Way to handle trouble</u> The <u>assurance</u> that I need to live one day at a time

> Lamentations 3:23 They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.
