Some Facts about Esther The name of <u>God</u> is never mentioned in the book

There is no mention of <u>prayer</u> in the book The book of Esther is never <u>mentioned</u> in the New Testament

It is one of two books in the Bible that bears the name of a <u>woman</u>

Esther, A Woman's Choice

The setting for the story is ancient Persia; it is the land that we know today as Iran Esther was among those who refused to return to Jerusalem following the Babylonian Captivity that stayed in Babylon Esther was an orphan Jew who was raised by her uncle Mordecai

Esther 4:12-15

¹² When Esther's words were reported to Mordecai, ¹³ he sent back this answer: "Do not think that because you are in the king's house you alone of all the Jews will escape. ¹⁴ For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?"

Esther 4:13-15

¹⁵ Then Esther sent this reply to Mordecai: ¹⁶ "Go, gather together all the Jews who are in Susa, and fast for me. Do not eat or drink for three days, night or day. I and my attendants will fast as you do. When this is done, I will go to the king, even though it is against the law. And if I perish, I perish."

Esther's name means <u>Star</u> Daniel 12:3

They shall be wise that shine as the brightness of the firmament and that they shall turn many to righteousness shall shine as the stars forever and ever
