God's Presents for Us

Matthew 6:25

1. The gift of care-free living

Vs.25 That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life—whether you have enough food and drink, or enough clothes to wear. Isn't life more than food and your body more than clothing?

Don't worry means to stop an action already going on

He says it five times in this passage

1. The Gift of Care-Free Living

Vs. 28 "And why do you worry about clothes?
Vs.31 "So don't worry about these things, saying,
'What will we eat? What will we drink? What
will we wear?"

Vs.34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

God's Presents for Us Matthew 6

The Greek meaning for worry means to rip, tear, or to divide the mind.

James 1:8

A double minded man is unstable in all his ways

God's Presents for Us Matthew 6

- Vs.25 "That is why I tell you not to worry about everyday life
- We are not to worry about the external physical temporal life
- William Ends, Worry is interest paid on trouble before its due."

God's Presents for Us A Google search for anxiety revealed 61 million two hundred thousand hits Philippians 4

⁶Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

God's Presents for Us

Vs. 26 Look at the birds. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for your heavenly Father feeds them. And aren't you far more valuable to him than they are?

A University of Wisconsin Study Revealed

40% of all the things we worry about never happen

30% of the things we worry about are things from the past

12% of what we worry about are typically criticisms made by other people toward us most of which are untrue

A University of Wisconsin Study Revealed

10% are worries about our health

8% of the things we worry about in life are legitimate

"Worry is like a rocking chair it gives you something to do but it doesn't take you anywhere"

Matthew 6:25 "Therefore"

vs.24 - No one can serve two masters. For you will hate one and love the other; you will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.

Ps.24

The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him.

Everything that you have you don't have

Romans 8:32

He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all--how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

God gives us, (1) the <u>necessities</u> of life and (2) <u>clothing</u>

Psalm 37:5

Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly abandoned or their children begging for bread.

Philippians 4:19

And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Matthew 6: 28-29

Look at the lilies of the field and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, ²⁹ yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are.

What were you worried about one year ago today?

31 "So don't worry about these things, saying, 'What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?' ³² These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs."

2. The Gift of Gracious Provision Does the Christian belief affect my way of life?

- ³³ But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- 32 For after all these things the Gentiles see for Your Heavenly Father knows that you need all things

Blessed is the person who is too busy to worry in the daytime and too tired to worry at night

3. Supervised Trouble

Vs.34- Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day *is* its own trouble.

I Corinthians 10:13- God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

3. Supervised Trouble

Lamentations 3:23

Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning.

Every morning when you wake up you are greeted with God's mercy

A Few Things to Walk Away With

- 1. Realize that God wants your life to be freed from the shackle of <u>care</u> and <u>worry</u>
- 2. Exercise a thankful heart for the presence of God and the presents of God which are his provision
