Understand the context of the verse.

Ask the basic questions, who, what, when,
where, how?

HOW TO CLAIM A PROMISE

2. Ask critical questions?

Is this promise I am reading is it conditional or unconditional.

Is this promise limited or unlimited.

HOW TO CLAIM A PROMISE?

3. Claim the promise.

You exercise faith, you say, Lord you have led me to this promise I claim it.

4. Act on that promise.

PAUL'S EPISTLES

Paul's epistles have the same outline.

This is what you believe-that is doctrine.

Therefore, this is how you live .

EPHESIANS 4:17-32

17 So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. **18** They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. **19** Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more.

EPHESIANS 4:17-32

20 You, however, did not come to know Christ that way. **21** Surely you heard of him and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. **22** You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires;

23 to be made new in the attitude of your minds; **24** and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

²⁵ Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body. ²⁶ “In your anger do not sin” Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, ²⁷ and do not give the devil a foothold. ²⁸ He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need.
