There is no greater activity than the worship of God alone. AW Tozer called worship the missing jewel of the evangelical church. "It is scarcely possible in most places to get anyone to attend a meeting where the only attraction is God"

What the Bible Says About Worship
Worship is mentioned over 400 times in the
Bible

In John it is mentioned 20 times

Worship Can be Confusing

Samaritan woman confused by her sinful past

Looks at life through the lens of her experience

Until sin is dealt with, we are confused about worship

Samaritan woman confused by her background History of mixed race and mixed religion (722 BC Assyrians captured the northern kingdom, intermarriage of Jews with Assyrians and pagans, Samaritans offered to help rebuild the temple, rejected by Jews,

Samaritans tried to stop with a letter [Nehemiah] 4:2] and with an army, built their own temple on Mt. Gerazim, their temple destroyed in 129 BC, but still offer blood sacrifices on the mountain, only accepted the first five books of the Bible) Our culture and upbringing shape our belief system

Worship Can't be Confined

To a Single Place

It's not where, it's whom (Acts 7:48)

We think of God near or far spatially - not a building, seat or pilgrimage (Jeremiah 23:23)

To A Single Activity

Not an event, a lifestyle

Has to affect life

Submission of lifestyle to God

Your <u>life</u> is a gospel

Worship Must be Candid
Truthful, honest, whole-hearted
From your own human spirit - pneumati
From depth of heart, core being, who you really are (Matthew 15:8)

Not worship - right God, right manner, wrong attitude (Malachi 1:6-8, 1:12-13)

Worship Must be Credible

In Truth

Based on the truth God has revealed about Himself in the Word

Tethered to God's truth

Failure in worship can be traced back to wrong thoughts about God

Worship Will be Consequential

Result of a relationship with God

True worshiper is a believer

You become like the god your worship.

Primary purpose of salvation not to make us happy or keep us out of punishment, but for God's glory.
